TRIP CHECK LIST

- Adult/Youth Information/Consent Form completed and notarized.
- Three copies of your passport. (One copy to leave at home with someone, one for the mission and one to pack in your suitcase.) **(These first two items need to be given to your group leader. For individuals coming, please give to the one that meets you at the airport.)**
- Necessary money to your group leader or mailed to the Highway Church of Christ, 128 Hwy Church Road, Judsonia, AR 72081.
- Personnel Hygiene supplies. (Your brand may not be available in Nicaragua)
- Small Personnel First Aid Kit. (Band-aids, antibiotic cream, anti-itch cream, aspirin, Tylenol, Personnel prescriptions in original bottles, Tums/Pepto-Bismol, Hand Sanitizer, etc.)
- Bug Spray
- Washcloths if you use them.
- Light Jacket or sweater (can be cool at night, year around)
- Rain Jacket.
- Work Gloves
- Personal Snacks...there is plenty of food but may not be your favorite snack.
- Flashlight with extra batteries.
- Sun Screen
- A notebook to journal your trip.
- Camera with extra batteries.
- Clothes – casual is the rule of clothing for almost all functions, ladies are asked to have a skirt for Sunday Morning worship (pants acceptable at all other times), work clothes, and hat. No open toed shoes during the work day. Shorts but not to be worn during the work day.
- Immunizations ...Tetanus is the only thing required. The mission has malaria medicine for times we go into areas that MINSA recommends the use of the medication.
- \$ 5 for VISA to enter Nicaragua.
- \$ 32 departure tax is now in most tickets purchased, check with the one that arranged your ticket. It is already in the tickets purchase for those through the mission.
- Additional cash...For those coming for a week, most figure that no more than \$150 covers all their extras for things to purchase to take home and extras during the week. For those staying additional weeks...no more than \$25 a week should cover any extra expenses. For our interns there will be two times during the summer we arrange a trip away from Jinotega for a couple of days to the ocean, etc. You will need \$100 for each of those times.
- Your Bible.
- A Servant Spirit.

THINGS NOT RECOMMENDED.

1. Cell phone (if you do, please leave it in your suitcase). Message can always be left on this number in the states...318-560-2868. This number will also be answered on days of travel in case of flight delays and travel emergencies. The mission has a local cell phone or it is recommended you call the states from the internet café in Jinotega. The mission # for calls from the states is 011-505-936-4538.
