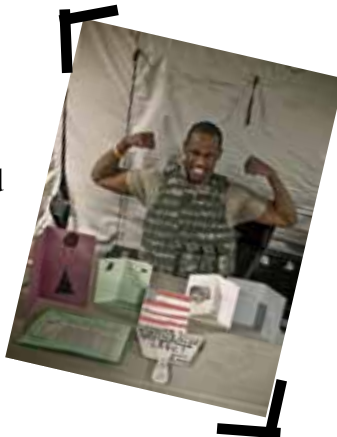
Dearest Ones,

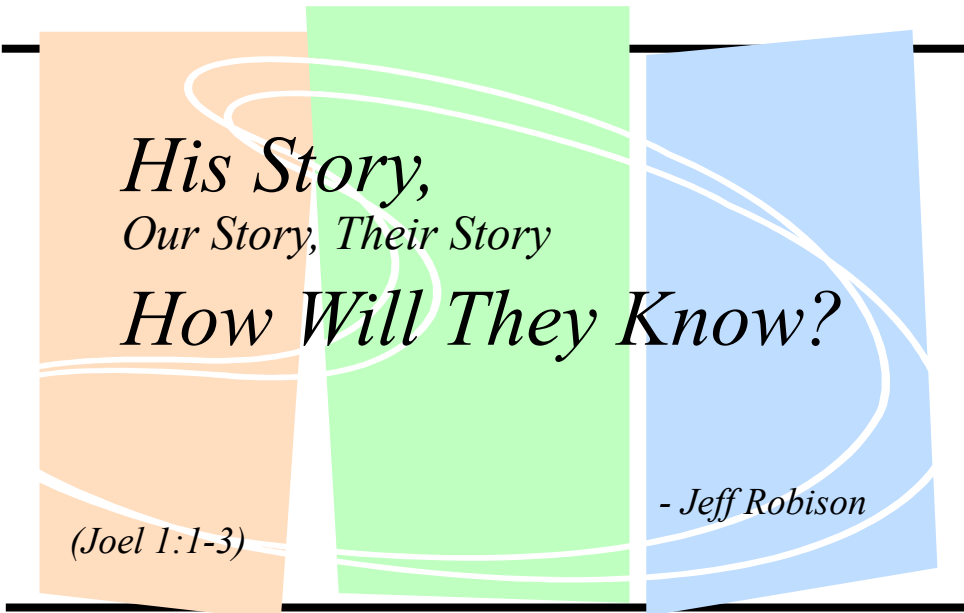

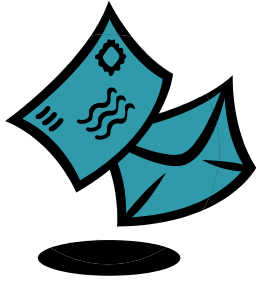
